The Wilderness Centre is proud to present a premier teambuilding program for 3 days and 2 nights on board a real working Tall Ship.

Team building programs are being conducted all over Malaysia for many different companies but none have a venue as spectacular as this.

For Clients who are in the North of Malaysia, or are willing to travel, we have positioned our 1st Ship "The MV Lili Marleen" around the beautiful islands of Langkawi.



For Clients in the Klang Valley we have our 2nd ship "The MV Puteri Mahsuri" in Port Klang, to make it easy to transfer the team on board quickly. From Port Klang the ship will journey to the Island of Pangkor in the north and return back to Port Klang.



Our program includes 3 full days of high quality facilitation, team building activities, problem solving initiatives, water activities and high ropes activities as well as full accommodation on board and all meals provided.

Participants arrive on the morning of day 1 and are straight into the action of learning about safety procedures, wearing harnesses, ship familiarization and climbing aloft up the ships masts.

With group challenges and problem solving activities the team will have to work together to complete the 3 day journey and achieve success in each of the activities.

Areas on board the ship allow for indoor and outdoor workshops and activities, company meetings and even Karaoke.

3 days of fun sailing in the Malacca strait, or around Langkawi Islands, provide many fantastic opportunities for team bonding, leadership and group development.

The ship is ready to sail now, so get your team together and set the sails for action!

Program Activities



Ship Familiarization

The familiarization session includes an exciting exploration of the ship and its many levels and hidden areas. The focus for this session will be safety, out of bounds areas and rules that need to be followed when on board. Familiarization with navigation equipment and many gauges and devices required for operating the ship are also introduced.

Climb Aloft

The masts that make a tall ship so impressive are very important in supporting the sails that move the vessel. Although these modern tall ships have an engine, it still has the capabilities to sail using only the wind. Having the skills and confidence to climb up the mast is a challenging activity and also very rewarding. Using essential safety equipment such as ropes and harnesses, participants will have the opportunity to climb at heights and experience a bird's eye view of the ship and surrounding area.



Abseil



This is a rewarding activity and the perfect way to return to the ground after climbing aloft. Abseiling provides a great challenge for participants and can require much support from their friends. Abseiling from a tall ship mast is a very rare experience and great fun.

Setting the Sails

Participants may get the opportunity to help the ship's crew to set the sails during the voyage. This is highly dependent on sea conditions, wind conditions and safety requirements of the captain.

Happy Hour

A tall ship requires a lot of maintenance and general upkeep. Happy hour is a time set aside each day for participants to put in a good effort to maintain the cleanliness of the ship and take responsibility for their maritime home. Happy Hour duties may include packing up equipment, cleaning their cabins, scrubbing the decks and general tidying up around the ship. This teaches participants to respect and value equipment and resources.



Knot Tying Session

A program on a tall ship would not be complete without learning some essential knots used in sailing and maritime activities. This activity teaches participants a variety of knots that they will need to know to complete some activities and others that are useful for many different purposes.

Rope Swing

This is a challenging and fun activity where participants are attached to a rope and swing out over the open ocean and back again. Ropes used are of an international load bearing standard and participants wear a harness to ensure their safety. This activity helps overcome fear and places participants outside their comfort zone.



Water Confidence

We understand that many participants have had little experience swimming in the ocean so we like to introduce any water based activity with a water confidence session first. All participants must wear Personal Flotation Device's (PFD) whenever they are planning to enter the water. We take participants through a series of progressions to get used to floating with a PFD and learning to feel comfortable in

deeper water.

Jump Ship

With a feeling of being on a pirate ship, participants will have the opportunity to "Walk the Plank"! This is an activity where participants step off the side of the ship and jump down into the water. This is a great confidence boosting activity and great fun.



Initiative, Team Building and Problem Solving Activities

Our instructors have many different games and activities that will challenge the participants in many ways. Some activities require clever planning, others require coordinated team work and then some are just plain fun! Participant's strengths and weaknesses are challenged in different ways and they learn a lot about themselves and the way they think.

Galley Duty

The Galley is the ships kitchen and plays an important role in maintaining the nutrition of all participants on board. The preparation and cleaning up of meals is shared by the participants and they will all participate under the guidance of instructors and Ships cook.
